Committee Meeting Minutes 25th February 2015

- 1. Apologies for absence: Karen Bassett.
- 2. **The minutes:** The minutes from the previous meeting, held on 14^{th} January 2015, were read and approved. Lynne Grebenik clarified that she has ordered mounts with an A4 aperture as well as those with 10×15 inch aperture as specified in point 3J.
- 3. Matters arising from the previous minutes:
 - a. Website, Twitter & Flickr David Weaver confirmed that the website. Due to work commitments David Neve has not recently checked the Twitter account; he will do it in the next week. Jarek Grebenik reported that there is an increase in the number of 'likes' that the Facebook receives.
 - b. Competition Images The idea to post the top six images of each competition will be put forward to the club for feedback. It will also be re-announced to the club that members can upload their photographs to the club website.
 - c. Raffle Lynne Grebenik confirmed that the raffle still continues its success and gives thanks to Ann Paulger for her help.
 - d. Membership Tim Higham reported that he has collected membership payments from two new members. Lynne Grebenik will pass on their details to David Neve when she receives it. The current number of members is 58.
 - e. Specialist / Educational groups Due to other commitments Jarek Grebenik has had to step down from hosting the landscape group. The position is open to anyone who would like to take it on. David Neve thanked Jarek Grebenik for his time, effort and dedication to the group. Jorj Malinowski confirmed that both the digital and print folio still continue their successful circulation.
 - f. Print Display Lighting David Neve will get the print stand dimensions from Gary Westwood and pass them onto David Weaver who will then design a lighting stand to fit.
 - g. Equipment storage The committee are aware that despite uncluttering the camera club storage that the club is still being charged for surplus storage space by the Cathedral Centre therefore, Tim Higham will contact Jackie (from the Cathedral Centre) to negotiate a reduced storage charge. Lynne Grebenik will speak to Tim Scott to remind him to clear his equipment from the centre's attic.
 - h. Annual Summer Exhibition 2015– Jorj Malinowski will make arrangements to hire the LPA frames for the exhibition.
 - i. St Barnabas Exhibition Nothing to report.
 - j. Sales of merchandise Lynne Grebenik reported that the mounts (in both size apertures) have so far had successful sales and she will bring more mounts in to

- k. Lincoln Camera Club Calendar Lynne Grebenik has had no feedback from L.I.V.E.S. Jorj Malinowski will contact 'The Well' Inn for a sales update of the club calendar.
- I. Lincoln Camera Club Bursary Jarek Grebenik made a presentation to university lecturers and 150 students giving them information about the bursary. This was a success. It has been decided that the level 2 students will need to give a presentation of their portfolios in May 2015 in front of staff and Jarek Grebenik along with two other club members. Once they come to a decision as to which students are successful, this information will then be emailed to the London Camera Exchange who will create a £500 loyalty card for each student. A certificate will be awarded to the winners at the third year student's graduation ceremony.
- m. Updating the Charity Commission Tim Higham will try to contact Charity Commission before the next committee meeting as he has still had no response from them.
- **4. 2016 Programme:** Jarek Grebenik reported that he has started to contact possible speakers for next year's programme. Following feedback from this year's programme, Jarek will organise 2016's programme so that the club will:
 - Avoid doing outdoor practicals in the winter months.
 - Remove the print critique night and replace it with two digital critique nights a year following positive feedback from the recent digital critique night.

For the upcoming studio night (held on 24th March 2015), Tim Higham will contact various local studios to enquire whether their facilities are available to hire.

5. Officers' reports:

- a. General Secretary Becky Strickson has received the booking forms and itinerary for the NEMPF photographic weekend which she will forward to David Neve to be emailed to the club.
- b. Social Secretary Audrey Stanley reported that past club president George Moulton has passed away and that she and Dave Hewson will be attending his cremation on 5th March 2015.
- c. Treasurer Tim Higham confirmed that Skipton bank are reducing their interest rate to 1%, therefore he will look into other possible banks with a higher interest rate.
