Your image should be accompanied by the name of the building/structure, location and its approximate date.

Congratulations to the winner of the Tipler Trophy

Congratulations to David Chapman who walked away with the Tipler Trophy in 2017. As with previous winners, David put images into most of the competitions and thereby increased his chances of scoring points. Of course it helps that the images you are entering are of excellent quality. For every competition you enter you are given a point i.e. you enter 1 to 3 images in the digital section of the competition and you will receive 1 point and if you enter 1 to 3 images in the print section you will receive another point. If you are then placed i.e. you win, you get 6 points. Second gets 5, third gets 4, highly commended gets 3 and commended gets 2. Your points are added to the score sheet, which is on the Club website, after every competition and you can check your progress throughout the year.
