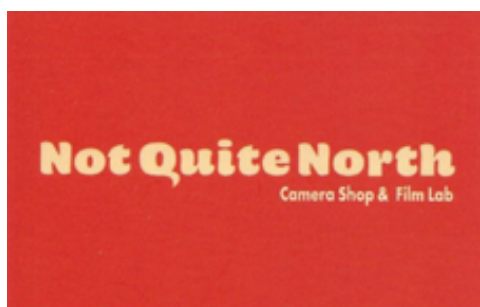
## Photography Shops in Lincoln.

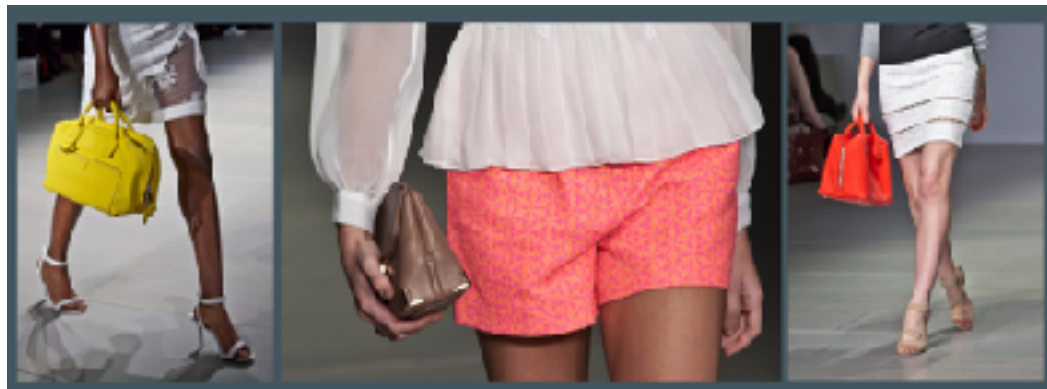
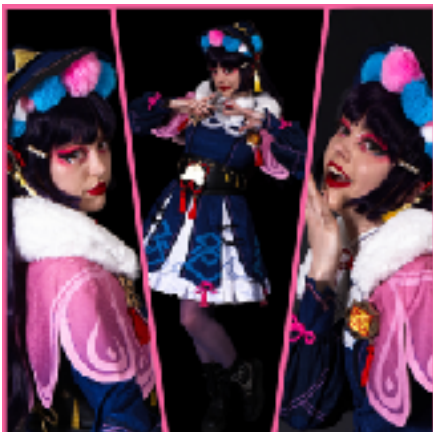

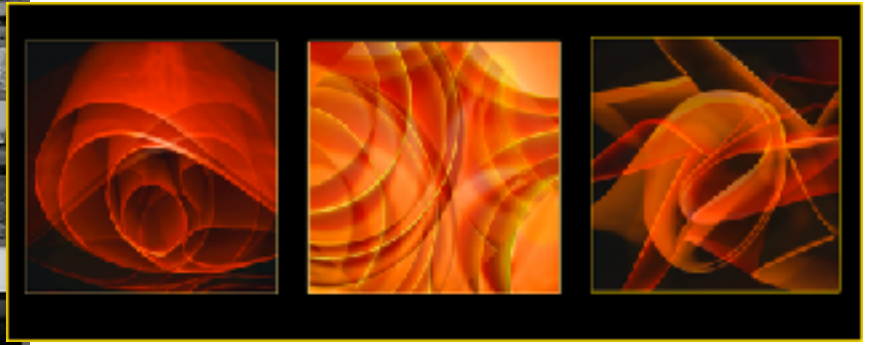
